## SUMTER CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

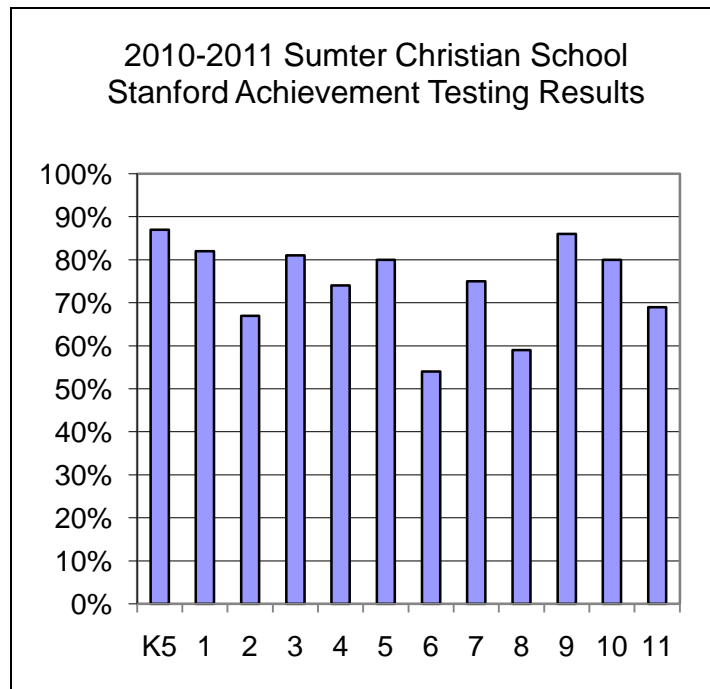
### FACULTY

15 full-time teachers in kindergarten through twelfth grade (a 15:1 overall student-teacher ratio)  
The average experience of K-12 teachers at Sumter Christian School is 10 years.  
27% of K-12 teachers at Sumter Christian School have a master's degree.  
Every teacher is a dedicated Christian who knows and loves our Lord Jesus Christ.  
Every teacher views teaching as a high calling to train children, not a profession to enter.

### STUDENTS

The average SAT score for the last 10 graduating classes is 1030, and the highest of last year's class was 1220. The average ACT score over this period is 22.4. Over 93% of graduates go to college.

The school's average score (grades K-12) for the annually-given Stanford Achievement Test consistently runs between the 75<sup>th</sup> and 80<sup>th</sup> percentiles, which places us in the top 20-25% nationally. The national average is the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile.



### CURRICULUM

A Beka Book and Bob Jones University Press materials are used primarily. The curriculum is strong in phonics in the early years and is college preparatory in the upper years. All subjects are taught from a Christian perspective.

### VALUES

Interwoven into the curriculum are Biblical values such as honesty, dependability, duty, loyalty, obedience, and respect to authority. Discipline is firm, consistent, and administered in a loving and caring manner, always with the goal of correcting and improving behavior, not merely as punishment for misbehavior. Our primary objective, and that which distinguishes us from other private schools, is to train students to be Christ-like in their character and actions.
