

Facility Health and Safety Guidelines

Parent and Student Information

Student Arrivals

- Parents should do their own health screening of their children daily before leaving home.
- Upon entering the building, all students in grades 6-12 should go directly to their locker, collect their books for first hour class and go directly to their homerooms.
- The doors to the church foyer will be locked and not used for entrances.
- Early arrival (before 7:45 a.m.) - all students 8th and under should go to the gym if arriving before 7:45. Students 9th and above should go to room 413 for morning care. The other buildings are scheduled to unlock automatically at 7:45. The office opens at 7:30.

Visitors Arriving

- Parents who pick up their children before dismissal time should come to the office.

Sickness

- Students should not come to school if they are symptomatic (fever, vomiting, diarrhea, loss of taste or smell, etc.). If a child becomes symptomatic at school, parents will be called and asked to get the child within an hour. The child will be placed in an isolated room until a parent arrives.
- If a child has a fever, he should not come back to school until 24 hours after the fever and all other symptoms have ceased without the use of medication.
- If a child has tested positive for COVID-19, they must be symptom free before returning to school. The school will not release the names of anyone who tests positive.
- The school office should be notified if your child or anyone in your family has tested positive for COVID-19.

Classroom Cleaning/Hygiene

- Throughout the day, teachers will clean the desktops, pencil sharpeners, door handles, and any other surfaces that are “high traffic.”
- Hand sanitation stations will be in the halls, and teachers will have sanitizer in their classrooms (K5-12th). Students may keep small bottles with them throughout the day.

After School

- After-care is available until 6:00 for all grades.
- Parents who pick up their children from after-care should ring the bell at the Day Care building (or gym), and a Day Care staff member will allow them to enter.
- Students in grades 9-12 who cannot be picked up by 3:25 must wait in the Secondary Bears Den.

Academics

- FACTS Family Portal is the primary source of information and communication (lesson plans, assignments, etc.).
- Band - students should clean their instruments daily.

Open House

- Drop-in from 1:00-7:00 p.m. July 31.
- Please be courteous of other families by waiting in the hallway or the opposite side of the classroom if the teacher is with another parent.

School Office

- Students will be referred by the teachers to see Mrs. Davis regarding temperature checks during the day, if needed. The office will be sanitized regularly day as people come in.

Miscellaneous

- Water fountains are available. Students may keep sealable water bottles in the classrooms. They may bring big bottles from home to keep in their lockers, or they may buy bottled water at school. Refrigeration is not available for students. We recommend that the bottles have the student's name on them.
- Masks are not provided or required
